The Reggio Approach is an interconnected system - a pedagogy of relationships

Saturday 11th May: 9.00 – 4.00pm

Early Years: 0 – 7 years Auckland Workshop

In this one-day seminar Tiziana Filippini will engage in dialogue with teachers to explore **the notion of relationships as a key pedagogical strategy**. She will explore the way in which educators, children, families and the community in Reggio Emilia engage in a process of **participation; giving value to and making use of relationships, collaboration and culture**.

This event is suitable for new and emerging pedagogical coordinators in the early years who have a deep interest in developing and supporting teams of teachers working with the ideas of Reggio Emilia. Participants will be knowledgeable about the Principles of the Reggio Emilia

Approach. They will have engaged in professional learning in relationship to the pedagogy of Reggio Emilia prior to this possibly.
